

## UNIFORMS

PASS FC strives to project a professional image. The club uniform plays an integral part in the forging of club identity, as well as building a sense of community and pride in the organization. This can only be accomplished if all PASS FC teams wear the designated club uniform kits so that no matter what the age group or occasion, the team can be readily identified as representing PASS FC.

## ORDER PROCESS

We have a two-year uniform cycle that renews during summer odd years (2023, 2025, etc) Players should order large for possible growth in the following year. Additional items may be re-ordered at any time to replace those that are worn out or outgrown.

- Team Gazelle will have uniform samples available for players to try on at all tryouts.
- Team managers will work with the Club Uniform Coordinator to assign a uniform number to all players on the team.
  - Confirm your existing player's jersey numbers, and then assign new players a jersey number that will fit on the team.
  - Players should be notified of their number along with the Team Gazelle link.
- Uniforms should be ordered as soon as possible **before July 1** (or February 1 for spring) in order to receive uniforms before their first competition.
- Players and parents who have questions may contact the Club Uniform Coordinator through the Contact Button on the website.

## PASS FC UNIFORM KITS

All players are required to purchase the required items in their team kit. The Team Gazelle order link will display required and optional items for each team and age group.

- All teams require a Home and Away Jersey, Shorts, Socks, Training Shirt.
- Academy and Premier teams may also require a Warm-up top and pants, a Backpack, and additional Shorts, Socks and/or Training Shirts.

## BLOOD UNIFORMS

A basic uniform kit (jerseys, short, sock) should be kept in the coach's equipment bag or the manager's tote to be used for temporary team use.

Please contact the uniform coordinator to obtain your team Blood Uniform.

Blood Uniform uses:

- Game officials are required to send off players with any exposed blood on their body or uniform, and players are not allowed to return until blood has been removed from the uniform and any wounds are treated and covered.
- Guest players may borrow the Blood Uniform if joining the team for a tournament.
- Last minute player additions may utilize the Blood Uniform kit until their new kit arrives.
- In an emergency, team players may borrow a uniform piece for a game day.

## INFORMATION REGARDING UNIFORMS

PASS FC teams play in various leagues. These leagues mandate stringent uniform rules that PASS must abide by. Some also provide league specific patches that must be adhered to the players uniform before their first match. Team Gazelle will ensure proper league patches are on player uniforms provided parents place their orders correctly.

All PASS FC players are required to purchase a new uniform kit every two years. Most supply chain vendors do not guarantee uniform style selections for more than 2 years and most children outgrow their uniforms within this timeframe and need to up-size.

- Individual players order their own uniform kit online through [Team Gazelle.com](http://TeamGazelle.com)
  - The Uniform Coordinator will help in this process following team selection

  - Team Gazelle will ship all ordered items directly to the family
- PASS FC uniforms may be used for off season indoor league play or tournaments when registered as a "PASS FC" team. Sportsmanship must be a priority while using the PASS name, wearing a PASS uniform and representing PASS FC.
- Specially designed team training tops may be designed and purchased by the team upon approval by the club and ordered through Team Gazelle. Coordinating this request with the Uniform Coordinator.
